#### **Extra-Curricular Items and Activities**

#### **\$User-Pays basis**

Watsonia North Primary School offers a range of items and activities that enhance or broaden students' schooling experience and are above and beyond what the school provides to deliver the curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis. These items/activities such as camps, incursions, excursions, sports and school photos are provided on a user-pays basis. Associated costs are published on Compass termly or before a specific event, where parents provide payment and consent. For our Prep cohort, we estimate this to be approximately \$230? per child for 2024.

#### **Financial Support for Families**

Watsonia North Primary understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund.
   Families holding a valid, means-tested concession card are eligible for the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF) that provides payments for eligible students to attend Extra-Curricular (OPTIONAL) Items and Activities.
   The CSEF is an annual payment to the school to be used towards camps and term expenses
